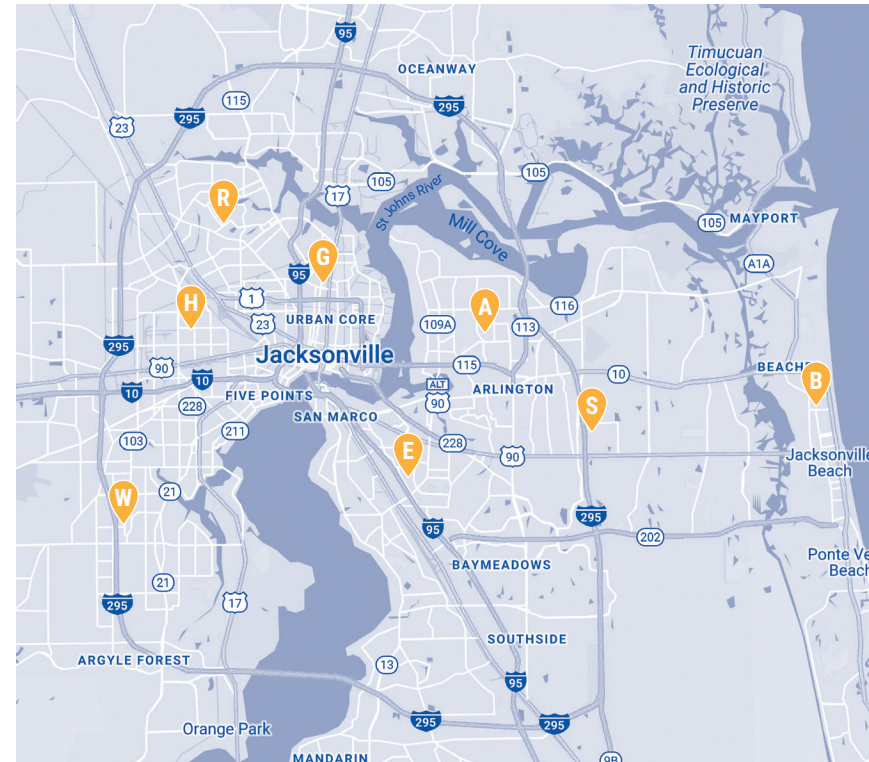
These days, their home feels more peaceful, the girls get along better and Elizabeth feels more confident as a parent knowing her family has the tools to handle life’s challenges.

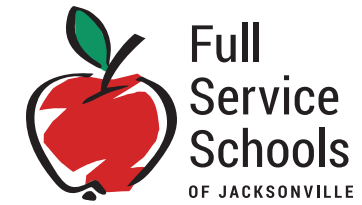

Full Service Schools provides free support services to Duval County Public Schools students and their families.

Each Full Service Schools family resource center tailors its resources to the unique needs of its neighborhood to support students' success and help strengthen families.

## Services include:

- ✓ Mental health counseling (individual and family)
- ✓ Basic needs assistance (food, clothing and more\*)
- ✓ Health and medical services
- ✓ Mentoring
- ✓ Case management
- ✓ Youth activities and events\*
- ✓ Parenting resources
- ✓ Substance use support

# How to refer a student for services

Download and complete the referral form, then email it to [ketop@uwnefl.org](mailto:ketop@uwnefl.org). A Full Service Schools staff member will contact you within 15 days to begin the process. This may include scheduling an intake appointment and having a parent or guardian sign a consent form.
